

Guidelines for the use of Ringerike Public Library

Everyone who visits the library should experience the library as a pleasant place to be. This requires everyone to show respect and consideration for each other.

- Clean up after yourself and your children
 - Threatening or disturbing behaviour (noise, harassment, odour, running, phone calls, etc.) is not allowed
 - Wear headphones if you are listening to music or watching videos/films
 - If you use the library's quiet room, you must be quiet
 - Food is allowed, but please avoid food that spills or has a strong smell
 - Handle the library's property with care. If you damage something you may be held responsible for compensation
 - Scooters and similar items must be parked outside the library
 - Service dogs are allowed, other dogs have to wait outside the library
 - Vaping or the use of other intoxicating substances is not allowed
 - If you break any of the rules, you may be asked to leave the library
